Description of the farm

Kannisto Farm produce rural tourism services for schools, day-care centers and adult groups as well as for families, business and private visitors. Kannisto is a traditional farm, with a diverse representation of Finnish domestic cattle and other animal species. Farm offers a nature trail and ball games, horse riding and farm chores. Barbecue shelter and saunas are available to order.

Services and animal interacts with its risk analysis has been prepared on the basis of the detailed security plans, and the farm has up-to-date security document. The staff can help you with the safety document and security plans.

Guests at the farm

Kannisto Farm receives day visitors, family vacationers, camp school children, kindergarten groups, seminar clients, nature and equestrian enthusiasts, clubs and a variety of family celebrations and other events organizers. Guest age, therefore, varies from 0 to 100. Guided tours are also offered for the disabled

Customer safety

The customers and the staff are constantly dealing with animals. Although the animals are accustomed to people, there is always the risk that something happens. The most common danger is caused by the customers' own act. Therefore, we will inform our customers about how they can contribute to their own safety. The most common injury is a scratch of a cat or a rabbit. For it is used disinfectant for the main building, medical and first-aid cabinet. Always behave calmly with animals in order to defend by scratching or biting. Also the dogs need their own area, please don't touch the dogs. Be careful with the dogs, cats, horses and other animals, if they are free.

If the customer has an own pet along, he is entirely responsible for the safety and behavior of the animal.

Ask the staff for guidance

- Clothing and footwear
- Safe horse riding equipment
- Farm and nature trail movement
- Handling and taking care of animals
- Emergency cases
- Torches in case of power failure

Alcohol and drugs are strictly forbidden in every activities with the animals and riding.

Saunas and grill: The customer needs to be especially careful handling of fire, alcohol use and smoking. Smoking is strictly prohibited in all rooms and nearby the buildings, as well as animal feed and dry hay, firewood and other combustible materials in the vicinity.

The most common riding and horse care risks

- fall back contusion, muscle pain, fractures, concussion
- failure to toe the hoof under
- horse bites or kicks, clothing breaking, contusion
- other injuries, slips, falls, collisions
- tools injuries

Horse Riding Equipment riders involved in

- safety helmet
- fit for riding, low heel shoes
- no caught like scarves
- a security vest

Kannisto Farm does not cover damages caused by animals to humans, other animals or property. For example, if the goat takes an object from the customer's pocket, the client has gone too close to the goat. For example, you may not put your hand inside the dogs' fence. When the dog is free, it could play with children, and this should not be deceived. The farm does not pay the laundry costs, if a goose or other animal stain clothing. Normal, healthy common sense must be present on a farm visit. Children can be controlled to approach the animals without unnecessary fear, however, under the normal caution.

NB. sauna

If you are uncertain about the sauna stove in use, such as firewood increasing, he must first ask the staff for advice. You need to ensure the cooling of the ash before the ash removal of the heater housing. Best use of the sauna able to advise the host. Sauna afterwards is the customer's self-aware of their state of health. Alcohol ingested cannot be heated saunas. Sauna beverages used in accordance with natural justice.

Attached is a camp school rules for all the comfort and security. Instructions can also be applied for school and day care groups and family guests.

Note: CAMP SCHOOL RULES for ALL well-being and safety!

I want to do my part to school camp as comfortable as possible.

School camp is a school, the school rules of order are valid for the entire camp at the school.

1. Taking part in the joint program and agree to a common timetable (waking up, programs, meals, bedtime, silence).
2. Going to bed and washing starts at the latest at 22.00 and the silence begins at 22:30.
3. Be polite to adults, and other members of the camp.
4. Follow good eating habits, and leave the table neat.
5. Take care of others in the room, keep it tidy and do not throw rubbish!
6. Kannisto Farm follows the safety instructions and mode of behavior.
7. Follow all the instructions of the camp adults (teachers, parents, and personnel).
8. Although there are a lot of adults, it is for each student to be self-aware of the daily program and prepare them yourself.
9. Mobile phones are usually closed. Internet is available only under supervision.
10. Do not carry any other consumer electronics. The camera can be taken at your own risk.

Kannisto Farm Safety Instructions and Orders

1. Do not climb the fire stairs. They are only emergency routes.
2. Throwing stones or other objects to the pond in the yard is forbidden.
3. Animals shall be treated, but their compliance with the usual precautions. Animal cages and gates securely.
4. Don't enter the animals' fences; they are animal shelters and territory.
5. After meal bring your dishes to the dish wagon and put food scraps into a bucket.
6. Making fire is forbidden in every case. Matches and candles are kept out of the school children.
7. The whole group stays together during the forest trips. Stay on the guided natural trail! Do not leave the group.
8. Going to the pool and saunas, special care is taken, not push, not run.
9. Incident or incident occurs, immediately contact the nearest adult. In an emergency, a meeting place for the flag pole area of the front yard.
10. Upon leaving the room is cleaned and rubbish taken into the bin. Check your baggage!

If the student does not obey the rules in spite of repeated rules and guidelines, the organization can send him out of the camp school. In this case, a parent is responsible for all costs incurred.
