FOR MERCHANTS AND AGENTS

MERCHANTS AND MERCHANDISE

The market area of Wuosisata Market is divided into two types of areas:

The Wuosisata area, i.e. the so-called Kirkonkylän Raitti, is the core of the market, and here must follow the traditions and atmospheric goal of Wuosisata market.

The rest of the market area is spread over the Vihti church village area, and these market places there are no similar requirements in terms of look and product selection, other than sober within the precincts of.

WUOSISATA AREA ON THE CHURCH VILLAGE RAITI

The products to be sold or presented must be

In accordance with the old spirit of Wuosisata market, i.e. handicrafts, art, literature, antiques and old stuff (no plastic or flea markets), natural products, products made from organic raw materials or foodstuffs.

Other products must be agreed upon separately

with the organizer of the event. Please contact us if you want to clarify the matter!

Products for sale should not be packed in plastic,

except possibly to protect the product when the transaction has been made (e.g. protection of a breakable object, food bag, etc.)

The organizer has the right to choose sellers and operators that fit the spirit of Wuosisata market, and limits the selection and quantity of sellers and products. If, despite the agreement, there are products in the area that do not fit the spirit of the area, the organizer can remove the products from sale or close the marketplace in question. Only pre-announced and approved products can be on sale.

OTHER AREAS OF THE MARKET

In off-the-beaten-track market and exhibition places, the product's craftsmanship or old-fashioned criteria are not so strict. However, the product or service must be suitable for the possible theme for which the place is placed (e.g. sports, politics, etc.). The seller/presenter will also come from these places

to tell what will be sold. The organizer has the right to choose the sellers and operators, and to limit the selection of products (products that do not fit the spirit of the market). Only pre-announced and approved products can be on sale.

STALLS AND VENDORS

Sellers and presenters are responsible for all the structures of their point/stall.

In the Wuosisata area, i.e. in the sober area, the style of the stalls must fit the spirit of the wanhanaja. Metal frames can be used as the frames of the stalls, and rain shelters are of course allowed, but these structures must be covered and camouflaged with natural materials if possible. Even in areas other than the sober area, the stalls must be clean, and as homely as possible

in accordance with the spirit of the village market.

In the Wuosisata area, merchants and performers must pay special attention to dress, so that it breathes the spirit of past centuries. Dressing in other areas is also expected to be in the relaxed, rustic and summery style of old times or village markets. This is our py-rim

all together to fulfill the visitors' expectations of the atmosphere of the event as well. If the seller violates the guidelines, for example by selling products that are not suitable for the event or the area in question (especially in the sober Wuosisata area), the event organizer reserves the right to remove the seller in question from the event. In this case, the seat fee will not be refunded. The organizer is happy to discuss unclear issues before making a seat reservation, in order to avoid unpleasant situations.

REGISTRATION, PLACES AND PAYMENT TERMS

Booking a place at the market is done by filling out the registration form. In the form, fill in the information marked with an asterisk. If the information is incomplete or does not correspond to the information we want, the reservation will not be taken into account. We do not take registrations by e-mail or by phone.

The organizer will respond to the registration by email. If the registrant/trader does not respond to the reply message he received within 7 days, it is considered that the place reserved for him is freed up for the next person.

The seat reservation is provisional until the invoice has been paid. The payment period on the invoice is two weeks. After this, the place becomes available again for sale.

If the seller reserves a place after the reservation period has expired, he will be charged a higher fee; Between 16.7 and 13.8 the increase is 30% of the price of the place and from 14.8 to 26.8 the increase is 50% of the price of the place.

SEATING

The base map of the event area changes subtly each time, and new areas may also be included. Also, the business premises of the entrepreneurs operating permanently in the area change, or the size wishes of reserved market places change the base a little every year. Places from previous years are not automatically reserved for anyone, but wishes are taken into account as much as possible. Requests are processed based on the order of registration.

The organizer places the sellers and presenters on the map. The placement starts as soon as the sale starts.

On the spot in the market area, the organizer shows everyone the place reserved for them, which may differ slightly from the exact place drawn on the paper.

There are limited places for food and electricity.

PAYING ON-SITE PAYMENT

The reservation is preliminary. The invoice will be m by the due date.

If the invoice is not paid by the due date, the spot earmarked for the merchant will be freed up for sale, and the merchant will be assigned a new spot when the invoice appears to have been paid (unless the old spot is still free).

Please note that if the payment is delayed, you will not have an earmarked place in the market area. The place will only be anchored to you when the place has been paid for.

Every entity selling or presenting products or services at the Wuosisata market, the Wuosisata area or other areas must be registered and pay the venue fee. If the organizer meets parties in the area who have not claimed a place through the organizer, the organizer has the right to remove the trader/presenter from the area.

CANCELLATIONS

If the invoice for the marketplace has been paid, and the cancellation takes place after this, the amount paid remains with the organizer as a cancellation fee.

FIRE SAFETY AND GAS USE

Open flames may not be used in the area, except in places agreed separately with the organizer, on a non-combustible surface. Each person using the fire as agreed in advance must have their own checked and functional initial extinguishing equipment. When reserving a place, food vendors must indicate the use of gas at the event. This also affects the placement of the place.

PERMITS, NOTICES AND FOOD SALES

The organizer compiles the following official notifications and statutory plans necessary for the event:

- event announcement about the organization of a public event
- safety and rescue plan with attachments
- organizes an appropriate ea point.

Shopkeepers are obliged to inform when reserving a place whether there is food for sale or whether gas is used, and how many gas bottles and what size bottles are in use. The merchants are responsible for the food announcements themselves. Those who sell food make a report to the food control of the city of Lohja.

Without proper notification, the organizer has the right to refuse a Sales Place without returning the place payment.

Shopkeepers who prepare food on site must keep their area clean and collect the garbage generated by the operation in a sorted manner (bio-waste, cardboard, glass, metal). The organizer strongly recommends the use of durable or natural material, such as paper-based serving containers, instead of plastic. Frying fat must not be allowed on the ground or on the grass, and the merchant is responsible for transporting the fat away. If the activities of the merchant or customers cause damage to the environment, the merchant is responsible for compensating for the damage.

SALE OF ALCOHOL PRODUCTS IN THE MARKET AREA AND ITS IMMEDIATE VICINITY

SuurVihdin Kilta ry reserves the right to sell alcohol products in the market area (with the exception of food stores in the market area with a permanent alcohol sales license: Ismet, Vihdin Kino and Candan), and in the immediate vicinity of the area

ELECTRIC

There are a limited number of electric points in the Wuosisata area at the market (close to the Poseidon Sports Center), and in the square at the other end of the street. Electric places are mainly reserved for food vendors. Shopkeepers must bring their own electric and extension cords, at least 20m, the use of extension cords intended for indoor use is prohibited. If the organizer notices these being used by the sellers, they will be removed by the organizer. Also, ungrounded extension cords must not be used.

INSURANCE

The sellers take out the insurances according to their own needs. The merchants themselves are responsible for the damages they cause to their own equipment, other sellers or the public.

SAFETY

There is a mobile first aid station in the area, which is available to traders and the public. You can contact them through the order supervisors or the organizer.

The seller is responsible for the safety of his own stall. The seller also guarantees that the products are displayed safely, and that they comply with possible product safety regulations.

Ex-date foodstuffs may not be sold. If the organizer notices them for sale, they will be removed immediately by the organizer.

WASTE DISPOSAL

The merchants' waste point is on the edge of the market, next to the fire station. The seller must deliver the waste to the waste containers at the end of the event, or take the waste with them. Everyone is responsible for the cleanliness of their place and its surroundings throughout the event. A fee of 250 euros will be charged to those who do not clean their place. If trash is found in the market area, the organizer has the right to charge €250 to the person at whose point of sale the trash is found. Garbage must also not be left in house yards or empty areas.

LOGISTICS

Merchants will be provided with separate instructions on moving around the event area and information about the parking lot where merchants and performers must park their vehicles. There is traffic in the area no guidance for traders and performers at 06:30 – 08:30.

Stalls must be upright and cars must be driven away from the event area immediately after the car has been emptied. Cars cannot be parked in the event area, private/public areas located in the event area or in its immediate vicinity (regardless of those separately notified) and vehicles are not allowed to move in the area during the event. This parking ban also applies to the area between Poseidon Sports Center next to the market and the fire station. If cars are found in this area, they will be towed away by the organizer and the cars will be taken out of the market area. Towing costs are paid by the owner/occupier of the car.

Dismantling and packing of the venue/stall can only begin when the event is over. Alu-ee can only be driven by car when the safety officer deems the area safe for traffic and pedestrians. For safety reasons, parking the vehicle in places other than designated ones is prohibited. Also during unloading, the trader must move his vehicle, if the organizer so instructs.

ANIMALS

We hope that pets will not be brought into the area, both for the sake of the animals' own comfort and because the show animals in the area (livestock yard, harness riding and performers' show animals) will be disturbed by the pets. Exceptions are the performers' animals, which the performers have agreed with the organizer, as well as guide and assistance dogs.

If the visitor has brought an animal into the area and it causes a danger or problem, he himself is responsible for the matter. The area cleaner charges the animal's owner 50 NOK for cleaning up the animal's droppings.

GENERAL CONDITIONS

By registering, the merchant/representative undertakes to comply with these participant conditions and additional instructions given by the event organizer.
