



2003

General field hospital to Barn, Iran, together with the Norwegian Red Cross, in connection with the 26 December 2003 earthquake.

2006

Basic health clinic to Pottwille Sri Lanka, in connection with the 26 December 2004 tsunami.

2005

General field hospital to Muzaffarabad, Kashmir, Pakistan, for ICRC use, together with the Norwegian Red Cross, in connection with the 8 October 2005 earthquake. Basic health clinic to Patikka, Kashmir, Pakistan, for ICRC use, in connection with the 8 October 2005 earthquake. 2006

Three mobile basic health clinics to Kerrya, in connection with the autumn 2006 floods.

2007

Two mobile health clinics to Sindh, Pakistan in connection with the summer 2007 floods.

2008

Mobile basic health clinic to Mutare, Zimbabwe, in connection with the 2008-2009 cholers epidemics.

2000

Surgical field hospital to Peshawar, Pakistan, for ICRC use, in connection with an increase in the demand for war surgery in the area.

2010

Mobile health clinic to Port-au-Prince, Haiti, in connection with the 12 January 2010 earthquake. Surgical field hospital to Haiti, in connection with the 12 January 2010 earthquake, together with the German Red Cross, Relief unit to Haiti, in connection with the 12 January 2010 earthquake. Emergency shelter services for 2,300 families to Haiti, in connection with the 12 January oto earthquake. Surgical field hospital to Pitrufquén, Chile, in connection with the 27 February 2010 earthquake, together with the Norwegian Red Cross, operated by Chikan medical staff.




