The twenty first century is an era when globalisation is shaping our lives more than ever – in economics, politics, entertainment and culture. It is also shaping health and healthcare in new ways – as pandemic infectious diseases, like swine flu, and lifestyle diseases, like diabetes and heart disease, sweep around the world with incredible speed.

But globalisation is all about people, and the movement not just of ideas but individuals. As the European Union has expanded, professionals and skilled workers have moved around the continent to find new work and new career opportunities. Nurses in particular travel far and wide from their home countries in search of job opportunities and career advancement.

As we travel across cultural, geographical and political boundaries in our caring profession, and care for people who have also travelled from their home nations, we face many challenges, professionally and spiritually. These are not new challenges – the early church faced them as they spread the Good News about Jesus from Judea and Galilee to the farthest reaches of the Roman Empire and beyond, in a time of globalisation that in many ways echoes our own. What can we learn from scripture and professional practice about how to respond to globalisation as nurses?

### The aims of this conference are to:

- Examine how nurses live with change, difference, uncertainty and opportunity in the light of globalisation and the gospel
- Reflect on professional practice in the light of faith and globalisation
- Explore future issues for the nursing profession in Europe.

The Bible Exposition will be on the book of Daniel and will be led by Pastor Beniamin Fărăgău (Iris Baptist Church, Cluj). Daniel was a man who lived across cultures and values as a Jewish exile in the Empire of Babylon, but who also maintained his faith and integrity.

The opening address of the conference will be given by Barbara White, President of Nurses Christian Fellowship International.

Plenaries on each morning will be given by leading nurses from across Europe on professional topics related to the conference theme and the Bible Exposition.

### Leadership Training

The leadership track during the Regional Conference will take place during the afternoon seminar programme, with the opportunity to attend another seminar of personal choice each day. The sessions will link to the NCFI Leadership Programme which has been focussing in its first year on Servant leadership. The primary model used for understanding will be the leadership style of Jesus, but the sessions will give an opportunity to explore the concept of Servant Leadership from a theoretical and biblical perspective. The sessions will provide a safe

environment for participants to reflect on their own approach to leadership, especially in respect to how 'power' is used in healthcare organisations. The hope is that participants will develop a sense of confidence in leadership style based on a biblical perspective. We expect the sessions to be interactive and encourage participants to bring for discussion real leadership dilemmas that they face in their professional life.

The conference programme will also include a full series of concurrent seminars and workshops in the afternoon and an excursion on Thursday 3 June (at no additional cost).

### Call for abstracts

Participants are invited to send in abstracts for papers (20 -30 min.) workshops (1.5 hours) and poster presentations supporting the main themes, as outlined above. This will be in the parallel sessions under "Seminars" as outlined in the conference programme. Speakers must read and sign that their presentation is in agreement with NCFI doctrinal basis (see [www.ncfi.org](http://www.ncfi.org) for details). Abstracts must fill the requirements set in the abstract form, which can be downloaded as a Word document from the NCFI Europe website at [www.ncfieurope.org](http://www.ncfieurope.org).

Abstracts must be sent by e-mail to Birthe Ørskov at [boe@ucsj.dk](mailto:boe@ucsj.dk) before 15th February 2010. Evaluation from the scientific committee will be sent out before 10th March.

### Scholarships

We will look at each case sympathetically, but we expect applicants for scholarships to be nominated by a member fellowship of NCFI. **We are sorry, but we cannot accept scholarship applications from non-nurses or from anyone outside of Europe.**
